

Piper Control Lock

Many times it is the simple things that have the greatest utility. This control lock was very easy to install and is so simple in operation that I don't see how any Piper flyer can do without one. It beats using a seat belt to lock the controls any day of the week. The strap hooks to both control yokes and prevents them from turning. Then another strap locks the control column to the throttle quadrant forcing the elevators into the full down position. This entire product only weighs a few ounces and can easily be stored in one of the seat or side pockets. The only metal component is the locking bracket that installs on the left side of the throttle quadrant by using two of the existing housing screws. The bracket becomes a permanent part of the quadrant. It has a steel snap that the control lock strap snaps into. The only tool you will need to install it in most Pipers is a Phillips head screwdriver. This is a wonderful product and I can find no faults with it. It also is available for the older "bow-tie" yokes. It is reasonably priced for **\$39.95** and includes free shipping. Please visit WWW.AIRPLANETHINGS.COM for complete details and to order.
